- BHC Registration Wireframe Summary:
 - Page A: Signature on the first page has been updated with David Yoder's. There is new section of text in italics to introduce members to the PIN which is required for the SMC and PHR.
 - Page B: Decline Button Function: The attached mockup includes a screenshot portion of how the decline button is functioning in development when clicked.
 - Page C: There is now a hover over the Register now button that is 2nd notification to the member that at PIN will be required for accessing the PHR and SMC.
 - Page D: Members who access BHA in 2010 will have program emails go to their personal email address. A check box must be unchecked if the member opts out of this correspondence.
 - Thank You Page: There is a new description of why a PIN is being issued. Programs available now are listed as well as programs that will require their PIN. Members have a LogIn call to action if they would like to log in right after the registration process. The User Name will auto populate and the member just needs to enter in their just established password. Reference/link to a how to guide is no longer a part of the page however they may still access the Interactive Site Tour.
 - PIN Gateway Page: Navigated to by either the PHR portlet, SMC portlet, PHR navigation bar or SCM navigation bar. Member enters their pin and is automatically directed into the section of the site interested in. If there is an error in how the PIN was typed they will receive an error message. If the member needs the PIN re-sent to their home address, the member can check their current home address listing via a link. The page will also let them know when the PIN was last requested.
